

To qualify for a rebate

- The High Efficiency Furnace Rebate is only applicable to Gas Permits issued after January 1, 2009.
- Rebates are issued to the Homeowner only.
- The new furnace must have an EnerGuide Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency (AFUE) of 88% or higher and must be replacing an existing low or mid-efficient furnace.
- The furnace must be inspected by a Strathcona County Safety Codes Officer and pass on the **initial** inspection.
