Players engage in regular season, exhibition or playoff games at their own risk and Strathcona County and the Summer Hockey League will not, in any event, be liable for damages, for injury or personal loss to any player, howsoever caused. Summer Hockey League will not, in any event, be liable for damages for injury or personal loss to any third party, including spectators, resulting from the actions of the league players on or off the ice surface. All players competing in league games must execute the Waiver and Release of Liability Agreement below.

**Waiver and Release of Liability Agreement**

The undersigned hereby acknowledges having read and understood the foregoing and agrees with it in all respects. In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the Summer Hockey League, related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates and agrees that:

1. The risk of injury from the activities involved in this program is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death and while particular rules, equipment and personal discipline may reduce the risk, the risk of serious injury does exist, and
2. I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of Summer County, the Summer Hockey League and their respective officers, officials, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct activities ("Releasees"), or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation, and
3. I willingly agree to comply with the Rules and Regulations and customary terms and conditions for participation. If, however, I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately, and
4. I, for myself, and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless the Releasees with respect to any and all injury, disability and death or damage to person or property whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise.
