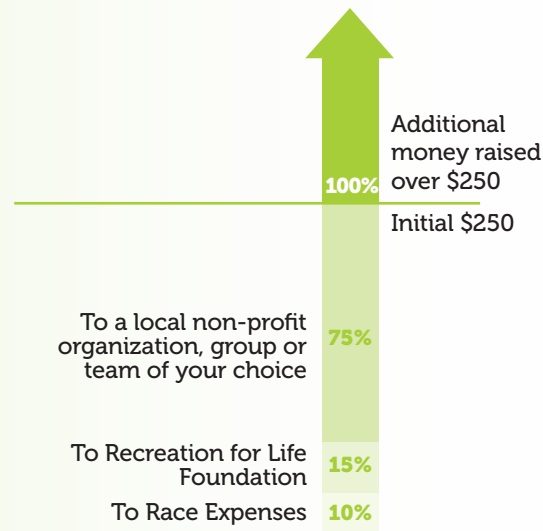
Stay and Play from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.
