

Under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* it is necessary for Strathcona County to obtain consent in order to use photos/video of people or to use e-mail addresses when the collection is not necessary for the operation of our programs.

Photo/video Consent

- Photos of the Junior Lifeguard/Extreme Lifeguard Club participants may be taken for the purposes of creating keepsakes or mementos to share with other members of their club and their families.
- Videos maybe used as a learning tool to analyze strokes and review swim meet performances.
- Photos taken may be used to promote Strathcona County programs and services. This consent gives Strathcona County the right to use these images in different media. These may include but are not limited to newspaper ads, brochures, newsletters and other print materials; transit advertising; and on the County’s Web sites. Though the images will be used only by Strathcona County, the materials they are used in may be distributed elsewhere.
